1 Can you remember which is your tree?
How many times your height do you think it is?

Take a guess at how many metres high it is (you are probably about I metre tall)

2. Get together with a friend and try this.


FIRST
Stand by your tree with your back to it. Bend over and look through your legs at the trunk.

## SECOND

CAREFULLY move away from the tree until you SEE the WHOLE tree between your legs.


## THIRD

Measure from where you are standing to the tree trunk by pacing along the ground.

This distance will be about the same as the trees height.

## NEXT

Find the distance in metres:

Multiply the paces by 2 if you are a short person, multiply the paces by 1 if you are a tall person

## 3 How fat is it?

Put your arms around your tree the distance right around the tree trunk is called the GIRTH.

Now measure the GIRTH in 'handspans'.
